



King's Scout Award on your WACE

Background: The King's Scout Award is an endorsed program. This means, your King's Scout Award is recognised by SCSA and counts towards a C grade on your WACE.

To do prior to completing your King Scout Award:

Because it's an endorsed program, your school can also give you timetabled periods (e.g. "Endorsed Program") to work on it during school time. Usually this is an only an option in Year 11+12. This period can help with time management.

For example, you could complete study during your endorsed program period giving you more time for Scouts outside of school. Or, you could use the period to plan for your adventurous journey or to complete Risk Assessments.

Talk to your Head of Year/Careers Office when you complete your subject selections for Year 11 (usually in Year 10) and they can organise this for you!

PS: You can also get additional timetabled periods at school if you are completing SAIT Qualifications!

Once you've completed your KSA:

1. Get your paperwork ready:

You'll need either:

Your King's Scout Certificate, or

A completed award approval form (available on our website, under *General Resources*)

2. Give it to your school:

Hand it in to the Careers Office or Head of Year so it can be added to your WACE transcript.

NOTE: Don't miss the deadline! Year 12s usually need to submit it before the end of Term 3.
